To cope with the larger, heavier and more powerful machines such as the T-Max and Suzuki Bergman, Michelin has developed dual compound tyres to suit. No excuse now for being left behind!

Government Helps Young People. A scheme to help young people get about on Scooters has won a £50,000 grant from the Government. The scheme aims to help youngsters in rural areas get to job interviews etc. It's not a lot of money, but it's a start.

<u>NEC Show 2012</u>. Lots of things to see and do at the NEC this year. There will be 23 motorcycle manufacturers and 8 Action Zones to keep you interested, as well as dozens of trade stands and fizzy (expensive) beer! There will be a Classic Zone covering the history of the motorcycle in the city of

Coventry. Custom bike fans can get a fix at the Custom Xtreme zone; there will be something for everyone. If you are a senior citizen (that's about 94% of the membership!) you can save a packet by buying your ticket at the gate.

Ariel to Reveal Motorcycle in 2013? All being well, Ariel, currently famous for producing high-performance road cars, will be revealing a performance motorcycle next year. Simon Saunders, owner of Ariel, is a bike fanatic and has been working on a bespoke frame and suspension for a Honda VFR-1200F powered bike. Saunders already has a deal with Honda, using the Civic Type R V-Tec engine in his road cars.
