<u>Cops Back Bikes as Two-Wheeled Transport (from MCN)</u>. Police and motorcycle industry bosses have called for an increase in the used of bikes to improve road safety as fellow motorists become more aware of two-wheelers. Rider safety has improved since 2000 but bikers are still over-represented in accident statistics, making up 1% of traffic but 19% of fatalities. <u>(see article further on regarding North Yorkshire!)</u>. More bikes means fewer jams and accidents. A Belgian study found when just 10% of car drivers rode a powered two wheeler instead of driving a car then congestion dropped by 40%. When 25% of car drivers shifted to two-wheels congestion was eliminated. It is acknowledged that motorcyclists make better road users when driving cars. So, get out there on your bikes and be sure to put out a positive image.

<u>North Yorkshire – Motorcyclists KSI Up!</u>. MOTORISTS travelling on the roads of rural North Yorkshire would have come across some gruesome scenes during the summer of 2013. Statics show that motorcycle tragedies happened with alarming regularity. Sixteen bikers were killed in England's largest county in 2013, a 200 per cent increase on the previous year, with the majority dying between the start of May and the end of

September. With 70 per cent of the fatal crashes caused by rider error, Tim Madgwick, North Yorkshire Police's deputy chief constable, is battling to persuade bikers to drive with more consideration. He says the failure of many motorcyclists to fully get to grips with the power of their vehicles on the increasingly popular roads, often riding in a manner more suited to the race track, can have horrific consequences. Analysis of the deaths over the year shows that bikers most likely to be involved were men aged between 40 and 59, riding high-powered bikes over 500cc. Of the 15 motorcyclists who died, only five were from North Yorkshire and the same number were from West Yorkshire, with a high number also coming from the more urban Cleveland police force area. The sky-high death toll from 2013 includes three separate fatal crashes in one week in August, on roads around Helmsley, Ripon and North Duffield. In the first of these, a biker was killed after overtaking at speeds of about 130mph and crashing head-on into a car, also killing its driver.

During 2014, according to the latest statistics on the North Yorkshire police website, there were 45 fatalities on the roads compared to 51 in 2013. The reduction comes mainly amongst the riders of motorcycles which fell from 16 in 2013 to 14 in 2014. OK, so numbers are down slightly but there is never, ever room for complacency!! Don't be one of the statistics.

Late News: report in The Times on Friday, 6 Feb states that accidents for 4 and more wheeled vehicles are up 4% in 2014. The increase is believed to be due to drivers fiddling with gadgets - smart phones, satnavs, digital radios etc. Every day I see drivers using hand-helds instead of hands-free sets; just what is wrong with people?
