Towards the end of the 2015 season I moved into the National League as part of the Kent Kings team. I have also had a guest booking for the Rye House team in the premier league. For 2016 I have just agreed to a professional contract with the Cradley Heathens at Wolverhampton. I have been

riding for only 2 seasons/years now and I have demonstrated much in the way of progress and would wish to extend that further with your help. It would provide a big step in the right direction and would be much appreciated from all of my team.
